Bring your jazzed up stock riding mower, up to 30 hp, with the following required modifications:

- Blades must be removed from the mower (All, no exceptions)
- Decks must be in place and securely fastened. May be reinforced to provide stability if necessary.
- Governors and linkage must be operational
- Steering can be modified for handling and stability
- All mowers need their race number fastened securely on the engine hood or seat back
- Noncompliance to safety measures means no racing and no refund

Safety Gear Required:

- Full or full-face helmet
- Gloves
- Long pants
- Long sleeves
- Boots or hikers that cover the ankle

Registration Fees:

- Adult Riders \$50.00
- Young Riders \$25.00
- Parade Only \$20.00
